Who is Eligible?

Candidates must...

- Voluntarily agree
- Be 18 years of age or older
- Reside within the 23rd Judicial District
- Score moderate or high risk on the TNRA's
- Have a **primary mental health** diagnosis within the last year or **LIKELY** have a current mental health diagnosis, if assessed
- Mentally and cognitively competent to maintain compliance with the program
- Not have violent charges or convictions- determined by courts
- Have all legal matters in other courts and/or jurisdictions resolved
- Agree to maintain sober living (drug and alcohol) through the entirety of the program

5 Phases

01

- Minimum of 45 Days
- Individual Treatment Plan
- Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Bi-Weekly Court Appearance

02

- Minimum of 90 Days
- Follow Individual Treatment Plan
- Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Bi-Weekly Court Appearance

03

- Minimum of 90 days
- Follow Individual Treatment Plan
- Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Court Appearance every 4 weeks

04

- Minimum of 120 Days
- Follow Individual Treatment Plan
- Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Court Appearance every 6 weeks

05

- Minimum of 21 Days
- Integrated Exit Planning
- Random Drug/Alcohol Testing
- Final Court Appearance
- **Graduation!**

If you are self-referring, complete the form to the best of your ability.

Signatures may have to be completed in-person once your document is received.
